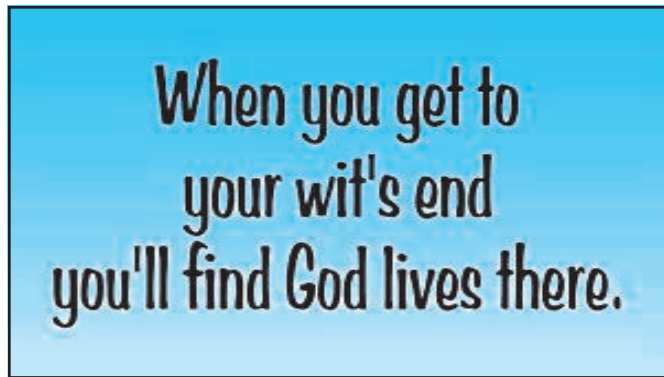

Holy Week Guidelines

As we enter the fifth week of Lent, we would like to provide some information and guidelines on what Holy Week will look like this year.

Palm Sunday - Palms will be blessed prior to Mass and will be handed out as parishioners enter church. There will be no procession.

Holy Thursday - The Washing of Feet will not take place. There will be no procession at the end of Mass. The Blessed Sacrament will be kept in the tabernacle. Parishioners leave in silence.

Good Friday - During the veneration of the Cross, parishioners may come forward and genuflect or bow. The Cross should not be venerated by touch, especially a kiss. Please wear your mask and social distance as you come forward.

Easter Vigil - The gathering at the fire will be limited to ministers only, parishioners will remain in church. No candles will be distributed to parishioners.

Easter Sunday - Normal Mass will take place. At St. Michael, we ask that you please sign up for Easter Sunday Mass by using Flocknote or calling the office by Wednesday, March 31. Masses are also streamed over the radio at both parishes if you would like to listen from the parking lot.

We have also been given guidance from the diocese that as of Holy Week, parishioners may begin singing at Mass as long as social distancing is observed and masks are worn.

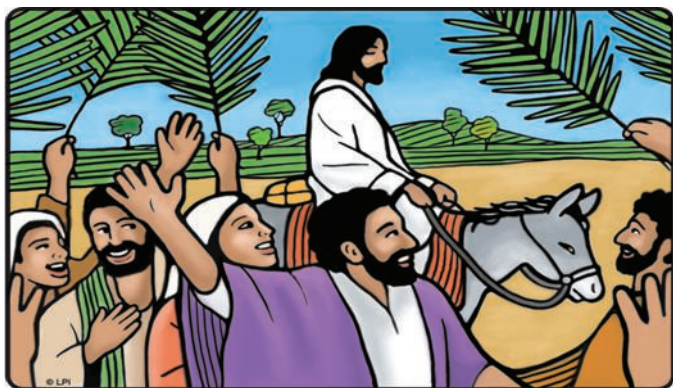
