- Social distancing guidelines will be followed.

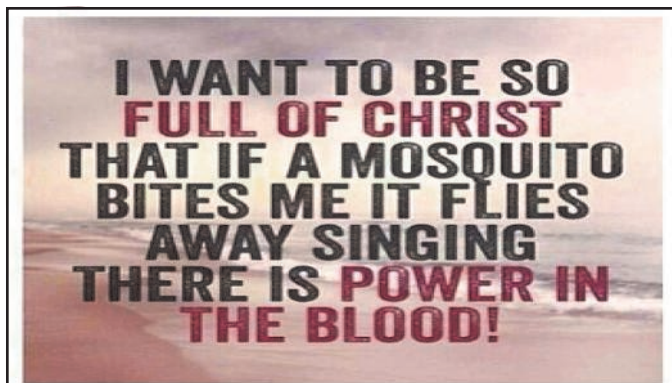

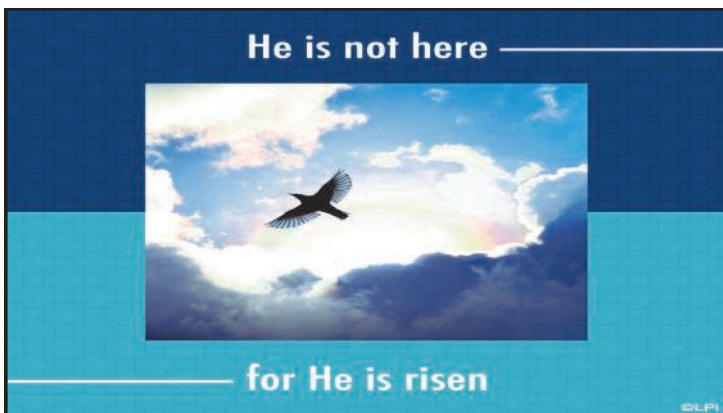


Congratulations to our First Communicants
