Oconto County Public Health will hold a walk in flu clinic on Monday 10/11/2021 from 9:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. in the Oconto County Law Enforcement Center Conference Room located at 220 Arbutus Avenue in Oconto. The cost is \$30 (cash or check), Medicaid, or Medicare. Please bring your Medicare or Medicaid cards when you receive your flu shot. Flu vaccine is your best protection against the flu and is recommended for everyone 6 months and up, with rare exceptions and it is more important than ever during the COVID-19 pandemic.
