Did you know that 16% of Oconto County school children are living at or below the federal poverty line and 49% are enrolled in the free and reduced lunch program. Through Nurse's Nook, a program of HSHS St. Clare Memorial Hospital, donors like you are helping fulfill the unmet needs of children and teens in our communities. This is done by providing basic need items (hygiene products, clothing, food and winter gear), improving access to medical equipment (blood glucose meters, crutches, inhalers, etc.), and addressing mental health challenges. Nurse's Nook assists students in eight school districts in our area plus two private schools. Thank you for joining HSHS St. Clare Memorial Hospital in this community collaboration. Because of you our schools are stocked with essential items that help children focus on staying happy, healthy, and in school.

St. Michael has been a supporter of the Nurse's Nook weekend backpack food program at Suring School for the past two years. Donations come from our Christian Service fund which is supported solely by revenue from our annual bazaar.
