Profits from our bazaar go to our Christian Service Fund. Throughout the year donations are made to help support several charities and outreach programs. In 2021-2022 St. Michael provided \$1800 to local food pantries (Care/Share & Christian Food Pantry), \$240 to miscellaneous charities (Rainbow House, Home Respite, Salvatorian Mission Warehouse, Dominican Republic), and donated \$900 to the Suring School Backpack meals program which provides weekend meals to those in need during the school year.
