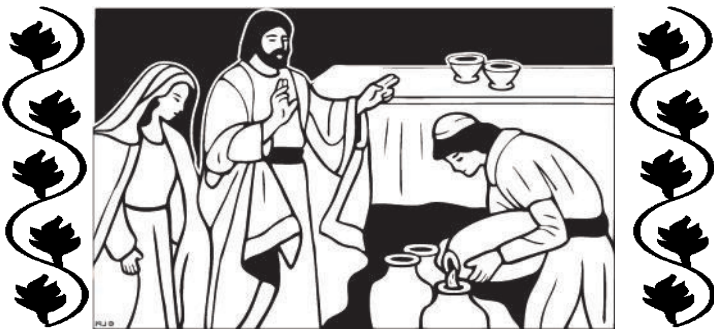

## Gillett Care Share Food Pantry

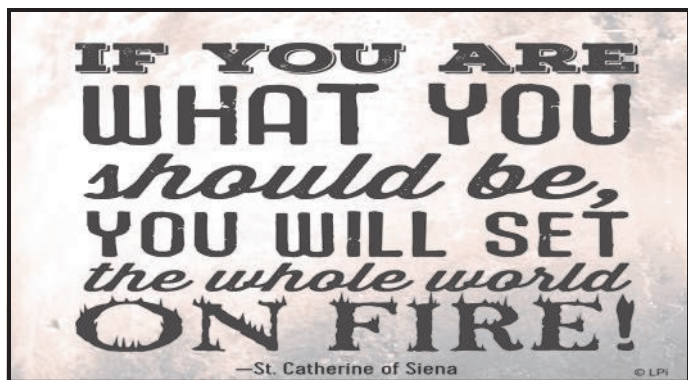
