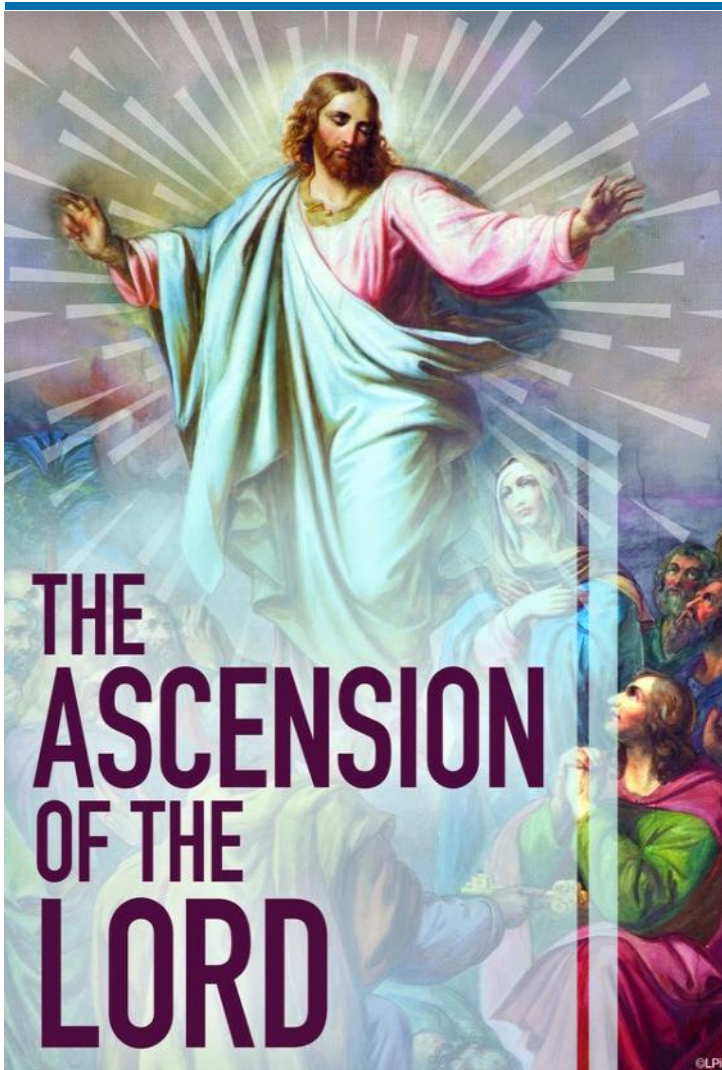

If elected they will serve on the Finance Council. Terms are limited to three two-year consecutive terms for a total of six consecutive years.
