Raising Vocations Collection

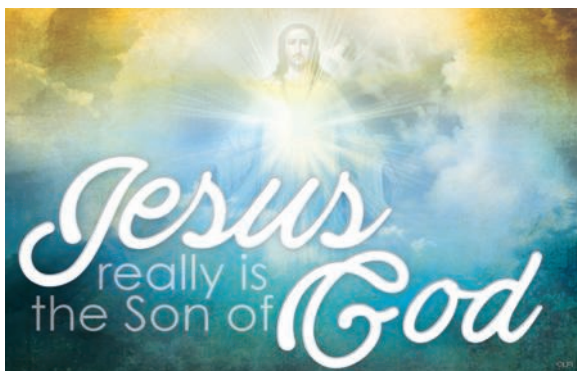
