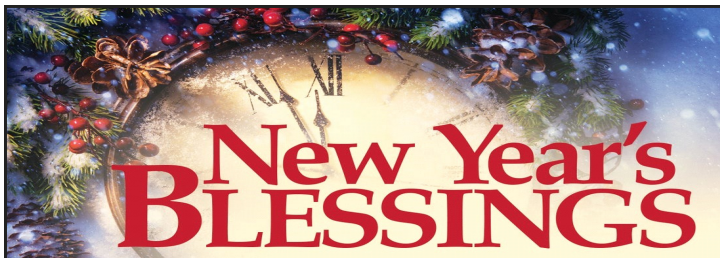

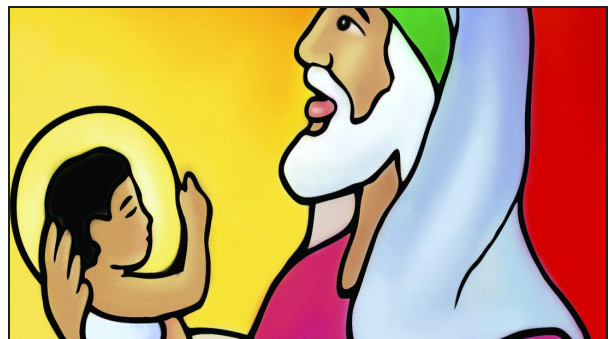

Holy Hour & Eucharistic Adoration

On January 2nd (St. John) & 3rd (St. Michael), we will have Mass and Eucharistic. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be recited during Holy Hour and the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed. Eucharistic Adoration is a centuries old ritual associated with the Sacrament of the Eucharist. The purpose is to acknowledge Christ's presence in the Reserved Sacrament, invite people into a spiritual union with Christ, and provide a time of reflection and meditation.
