St. Michael & St. John Eucharistic Procession

On June 2nd at the 8:45 and 10:15 AM Masses we will hold a Eucharistic Procession to celebrate Corpus Christi. This is also the day when the practice of the distribution of Holy Communion under both kinds will begin in accordance with the Diocesan Instruction. Celebrations at which Holy Communion under Both Kinds is that Distribution of Holy Communion from the Cup may only take place and is encouraged on:

- All the faithful who participate in the Easter Vigil
- The Christmas Mass During the Night (Midnight Mass)
- Holy Thursday, Mass of the Lord’s Supper
- All weekend Masses on: Divine Mercy Sunday, The Solemnity of Pentecost, The Solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity, The Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Corpus Christi), The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.
- First Holy Communion (Only First Communicants)
- Wedding Mass (Only Bride and Groom)
- The Mass celebrating the patronal feast of each oratory, church, parish, or mission
- The anniversary Mass celebrating the dedication of each church
