Updated Stipend & Stole Fee Structure

The Diocese of Green Bay and our parishes are grateful to all those who have generously provided a donation for Masses, funerals, and weddings in the past. The donation for these sacraments has remained the same for over thirty years throughout the Dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time. The new stipend structure is as follows: Mass Stipend - \$20, Funeral Stole Fee - \$75, and Wedding Stole Fee - \$100. The new fees will become effective July 1, 2024. The increase will **not** be applied retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount from the former fee scale. The new fees will be applied to all new requests received as of July 1, 2024.
