Polka Mass and Social Gathering

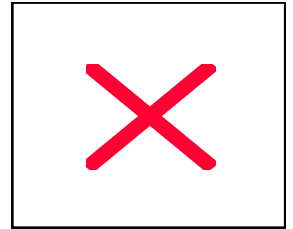
