Profits from our bazaar go to our Christian Service Fund. Throughout the year, donations are made to help support charities and outreach programs. In 2023-2024 St. Michael donated \$2715. We provided \$1800 to local food pantries (Care/Share & Christian Food Pantry), \$240 to miscellaneous charities (Rainbow House, Home Respite, Salvatorian Mission Warehouse, Dominican Republic), and \$675 to the Suring School Backpack meals program which provides weekend meals to those in need during the school year.
