DECREE



The Sacrament of Penance and the Sacrament of the Eucharist may be received several days before or after performing the prescribed act. Additionally, for those who cannot participate in the various solemn celebrations, pilgrimages, and pious visits for serious reasons (especially cloistered nuns and monks, elderly, the sick, and prisoners) by living their lives with faith and joyful hope in the midst of their trials and by receiving holy communion or attending mass, if necessary, through various forms of media. For those who are incarcerated, they may receive the indulgence by praying in their prison chapels. Furthermore, since the experience of hope becomes visible in the witness of concrete signs as Jesus Himself taught us, for those members of the faithful who perform any of the spiritual or corporal works of mercy, these too shall surely obtain the jubilee indulgence. As Christians hope will not disappoint as it is grounded securely in God's abiding Love. May this Jubilee be a time of renewed hope that awakens in hearts the hope of salvation in Christ.
