Water is a basic need of every human being. During this Lenten season we will be collecting donations to support the efforts of the Diocese of Sivagangai in India to provide school children access to clean drinking water as well as proper sanitation facilities. The Diocese of Sivagangai is in the southern part of India. Most people are farmers and fishermen. The region is dry, and reliant on monsoons. The aim of the diocese is to provide safe water and sanitation to the communities within the diocese with the focus on safeguarding the health of young children. Since 2015 they have helped seven communities receive clean drinking water through the building of wells and improving sanitation in the local schools. A gift of \$1000 will provide one well.
