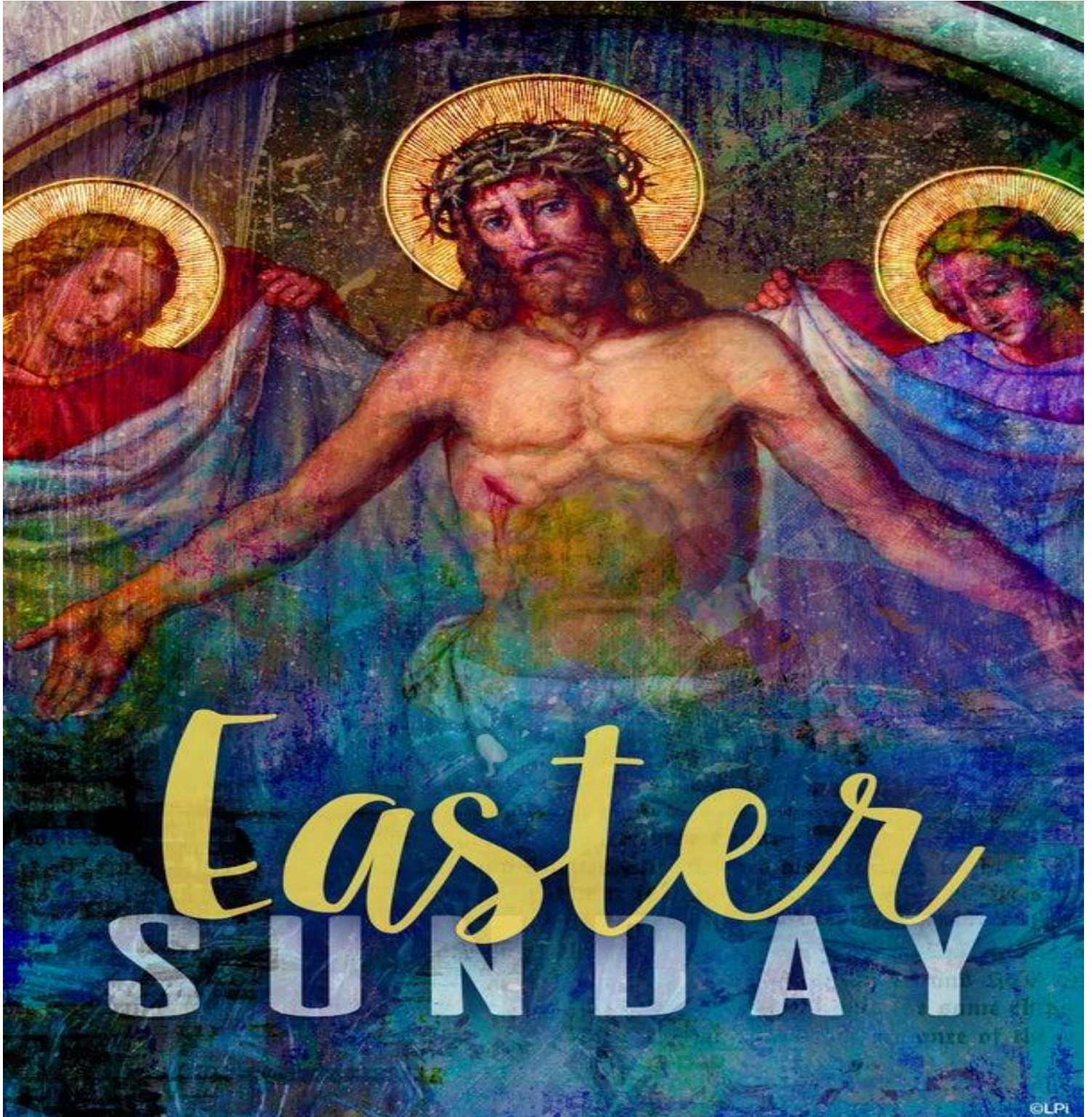

EASTER 2025


The Lord is risen. Alleluia! Alleluia!
