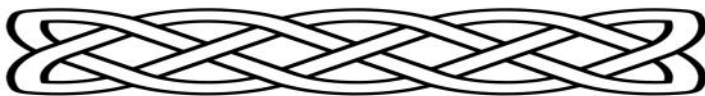
Pope Francis

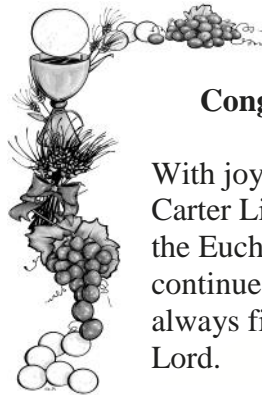

EXCERPTS FROM: ST. FAUSTINA

KOWALSKA'S DIARY that inspired the Institution of the FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY.

JESUS revealed to her: *“I want the first Sunday after Easter to be the Feast of Mercy.” (Diary 299) “I want the Feast of Mercy to be a refuge and sanctuary for all souls and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the depths of My mercy are open. I pour out a whole sea of graces on souls that approach the fount of My mercy. Any soul that makes its Confession and receives Holy Communion will have its sins and its punishment completely remitted. On that day are open all the Divine floodgates through which graces flow.” (Diary 699)*
